### Overview of Admissions Procedures

**Exchange students**, including those participating in the ERASMUS program, must complete their registration with the International Office of Rennes 2 University. For more information, see the section for Exchange Students (<https://international.univ-rennes2.fr/studying/exchange-students>).

**CIREFE students** should complete their registration with the CIREFE at Rennes 2 University. See the CIREFE website for more information on program options and pricing. (<https://sites-formations.univ-rennes2.fr/cirefe/en/cirefe-learn-french-in-rennes-discover-brittany/>)

**Individual students** (international students pursuing a Bachelor's or Master's degree, and who are not part of an exchange program) should follow instructions as listed in the following section. Procedures (<https://international.univ-rennes2.fr/studying/individual-or-non-exchange-students>) will vary depending on one's nationality and other criteria.

**PhD students** must contact Rennes 2 University before their departure, as the procedures for registration are different depending on their residency status and the duration of their stay.

### Find out if you will require a visa in order to study in France

Since April 17, 2021, international students can apply for an online visa on France-Visas. The new service is accessible to students applying for a long stay visa living in a country where visa application is outsourced and available online. Through the service, students can submit digital copies of their supporting document during completion of their online visa application. This service helps accelerate the transfer to the outsourced service provider. Find out more information on the Campus France website.
