The Disability Services' Actions

You have a disability or another health issue, you can benefit from the help of the Disability Services:

The Disability Services of Rennes 2 University's main mission is supporting disabled students and students with other health issues that prevent them from studying effectively (such as a broken bone, a serious illness, etc.)

They coordinate each accommodation needed by students (tutoring, help with note-taking, document adaptation, physical accessibility, exams, extra time, insertion in the job market, etc.) and make sure the University's other services, mainly the Health center (SIMPPS) and the different departments, are made aware of them.

A specific reception:

- confidential and individualized
- identification and evaluation of the student's needs
- information on the accommodations available at the Disability Services
- awareness of the specifics of university life
- visits of the La Harpe and Villejean campuses

Making your studies accessible:

Your studying environment can be adapted with the help of the educational team, including:

- an analysis of the student's needs and the organization of the educational supports
- help with note-taking: students can receive class notes taken by another student
- the help of a French Sign Language specialist or a French Cued Speech specialist
- the transcription of documents in Braille
- accessible software can be made available (Dragon Naturally Speaking, Viavoice, etc.), as well as accessibility tools (magnifiers, video enlarger, etc.)

A specific exam organization:

Exams can be made accessible with the help of the educational team, including:

- the organization of exam sessions in accordance with your specific accommodations
- extra time on oral and written exams
- an exam secretary can be made available
- an individual room can be made available (under certain conditions, it is possible to take your exams alone or in a small group in a separate room.)
- the transcription of exam questions in Braille
- adaptations in the wording of the exam questions
- a computer can be loaned, whether the exam is taken at the Disability Services or in the exam room.
- the presence of a French Sign Language specialist or a French Cued Speech specialist

Each student has a right to these accommodations after making an appointment with one of the University Health Center's doctors and explaining their situation. (see contacts on the back of the booklet)

Practical information:

Housing and food services

The Centre Régional des Oeuvres Universitaires et Scolaires (C.R.O.U.S.) is traditionally in charge of housing and food services.

- **Housing:**

The C.R.O.U.S. has accessible housing available for disabled students and students with other health issues.

- **Food services:**

There are accessible food courts on campus as well as an accessible University restaurant in close proximity to Rennes 2 University.

- **The metro (direct access to the Villejean campus):**
