A tailor-made system on each university campus:

Since Monday, January 25th, students have been invited to get tested free of charge in less than 30 minutes, with results, on the Beaulieu, Villejean, Centre and Ker Lann campuses, from 1:00 pm to 5:30 pm, without an appointment:

- Rennes 2's Villejean Campus: Campus Santé, 2 avenue du Professeur Léon Bernard, Bâtiment 01, Salle 012, Cafétéria des Professeurs.
- Campus de Beaulieu: 263 avenue du Général Leclerc, Building 01A, Room 03, Club des Professeurs
- Campus Centre : Faculté des Sciences Economiques, 7 place Hoche, Bâtiment 01, Salle 091, Salle des actes
- Ker Lann Campus: Maison du campus, Contour Antoine de St Exupéry in Bruz
