French Courses at the CIREFE (for International Researchers)

The Center for International Mobility in Rennes (CMI Rennes), in partnership with the CIREFE (Centre International Rennais d'Etudes de Français pour Etrangers) Rennes 2 University, offers French as a Foreign Language (FLE) courses for a fee for researchers and doctoral students of the CMI Rennes member institutions.

- Exposition | Tarot Trans
 - From Jan.16 to March 10
 - "Tarot Trans" is a photographic project by Chilean artist Zaida González Ríos that appropriates the 22 major arcana of the Tarot by replacing the figures on the cards with non-standardized models, such as transgender people, migrants, disabled people, elderly people and others who correspond to the meaning of the assigned card. - Equality Tuesdays: Contemporary Art and Queer Culture
 - Jan. 17, 2023
 - With Quentin Petit Dit Duhal, Doctor in Art History, a temporary teaching and research associate, and co-founder of ARQ (*Arts et Représentations Queer*), a research collective on the history of feminist and queer arts.
 - This conference proposes a study of images and trajectories of queer artists by putting into context their commitment and the way they displace the
 categories of gender, sex and sexuality. It shows that these artists, through their representations, have a very direct impact in the transformation of
 society. We will also see the stakes that queer represents for the history of art and how it feeds new discourses on the non-standard, the exclusion and
 the hierarchy, in particular thanks to the research of young researchers. See more here.

Other things to keep in mind as a new arrival:

Residence permits and long-stay visas

If your residence permit/long-stay visa expires in two months or less, there is still time to apply, even if you do not yet have the new 2022/2023 registration or your final transcript.

The most important thing is to file the application at least two months before the expiration of the current residence permit (this is the deadline stipulated in the regulations). Find out everything you need to know with help from the CMI Rennes.
