### What is it?

The educational third place is a welcoming and shared space dedicated to exchange, creativity, and hands-on learning.

With this new space—open to all library users, modular, and connected—the university libraries are diversifying their work and training environments. The third place offers:

- · A modular training area and collaborative workspaces
- Equipment and materials to support creativity and experimentation
- Workshops and events aimed at supporting student success

This space was launched in response to a call for proposals and developed in collaboration with university departments (Teaching Support Office [DAP], Edulab), and our partners (Training Center for Library Careers – Brittany – Pays de la Loire [CFCB] and the Regional Unit for Training in Scientific and Technical Information [Urfist]).

# **Available Equipment**

- · An informal workspace and reception area
- **Group work rooms**, including two "bubbles" for 4 and 6 people, and one room for 10. These function like the other group work rooms in the library. They can be reserved online or used freely when not occupied.
