

TELME Erasmus Mundus Joint Master's Programme: Final Call for Applications



This distinctive programme, co-funded by the European Union, focuses on multilingual language education and offers students the opportunity to combine academic excellence with practice-oriented training and strong international mobility. **Prospective students who speak at least two languages** are reminded that only a short time remains to apply.

The programme is designed for candidates seeking advanced qualifications in multilingual language education, including future language teachers, course and curriculum designers, and programme coordinators working in international and intercultural contexts. **Applicants must demonstrate proficiency in English and at least one additional language (French, Spanish, or German).** Eligible candidates are strongly encouraged to submit their applications before the deadline.
